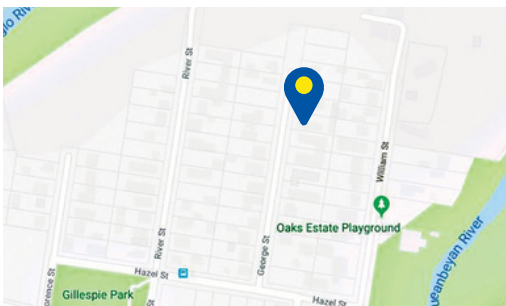

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The St Vincent de Paul Society Canberra/Goulburn Community Inclusion Program (CIP) provides tenancy support services to Residents (companions) living in Social and Community Housing in River and George Streets Oaks Estate only. The program also links rough sleepers to supports and services requested to provide a pathway out of homelessness.

Located at Oaks Estate in Canberra, CIP responds to the needs of Residents (companions), improves social cohesion and has a community development aspect too. CIP hosts a monthly Peer Support Meeting and has a community room that provides tea and coffee 8am to 11am Monday to Friday. The Community Room has free internet access too Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm.

Vinnies Specialist staff provide advocacy, case management, support, transport services, information and referral to external services catered to each individual's needs. In a safe, respectful and welcoming environment, the program engages with a range of supports and services onsite weekly to meet the needs of companions.
