

We are currently in need of donations for the Vinnies stores, particularly Homeware items! By donating your pre-loved homewares to Vinnies stores they will get a new life. The money earned by selling pre-loved homewares in our Vinnies stores will support Victorians doing it tough and reduce landfill and the impact on the environment.

How It Works

- 1 Set up a School Comp: Each school house (team) are encouraged to gather as many homeware items as possible. Set a timeframe such as a week (like Homelessness week) and a designated drop-off location for each house. Make it a fun and engaging competition with rewards for the house that collects the most.
- **2 Gather Donations:** We are asking for schools to collect crockery, artwork, pottery, picture frames, candles, cookware, containers, and more. Use archive boxes for fragile items to ensure safe transport.
- **3 Donate to Vinnies:** Organise a drop off or pick up of your donations at your local Vinnies store. Ensure items are clean and in good condition.

Items we need urgently

- Decorative crockery and ceramics
- Artwork, sculptures or ornaments
- Candles, ambience, soft furnishings
- Vases, bowls, pottery and dishes
- Picture frames and prints
- Cookware, Tupperware and storage

Donation tips



- Donate clean, good quality homewares and bric-a-brac.
- Place items in a bag or box before donating. (For fragile items, an archive box with handles is preferrable).

Donation Don'ts:

- Do not leave donations outside shops when closed.
- Do not place glassware or breakable items in charity bins.

How to Donate:

- Drop-off: Bring your donations to your local Vinnies shop during business hours.
- Pickup: If your School teams really get behind the project, we can arrange to collect if you have 100+ boxes.
